THE VERY BEST GIFT



The crème de la crème of gifts is found in the Holy Bible.

*For the wages of sin is death; but the **gift** of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 6 : 23)*

The word **gift** here is charisma in Greek and one meaning is a favour which one receives without any merit of his own.

Mathematically

The **Gift of God** = Eternal Life ... and is available through The Lord Jesus Christ.

Like all gifts somebody had to pay for it and Jesus paid for it not with silver and gold but with His precious blood (1 Peter 1:18, 19). When you die your body will go to the grave or ashes but where will your spirit and soul go? The Bible makes it clear there are two places in eternity ... heaven and hell. There is no such place as purgatory or limbo. Check it out for yourself by looking at a Bible concordance (an alphabetical index of words in the Bible).

Limited Time Offer

The gift is available only for a limited time. You must pick it up before you die and in fact God urges you to pick it up NOW.

...behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation. (2 Corinthians 6:2 b)

*Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth.
(Proverbs 27: 1)*

Like all gifts you can accept the gift or reject it. If you want to accept the gift pray the following prayer (on back page). Before you pray remember that if you believe in heart and confess with your mouth you can be saved according to Romans 10: 9, 10.

*That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
(Romans 10: 9, 10)*
